Requirements:	You must enjoy meeting and talking to people and have a friendly and caring personality. You will be reasonably fit to manoeuvre Shopmobility equipment, be methodical in your approach and confident to carry out all tasks in a friendly and professional manner.
What's in it for You:	You will learn new skills, meet interesting people and help them to retain their independence when shopping. Whether you are recently retired, or just have some spare time on your hands you will be joining a supportive and friendly team and feel like you are doing something worthwhile for yourself and other people. You will receive full training and on-going support, not to mention copious cups of coffee!
